January 2, 2018 Board of Supervisors Reorganization Meeting Minutes

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, of Adams County, met Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at 7:30 PM at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Road, Fairfield, PA 17320, for the annual reorganization meeting.

Mr. Barlow moved to appoint Wendy Peck as Chief Administrative Officer for all township pension plans. Mr. Bostek seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Mr. Jackson moved to intend to appoint Smith Elliot & Kerns on January 18 as the Township auditor for 2017 Audit. Mr. Barlow seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Mr. Bostek moved to set meeting dates and times for the year 2018 with the Board of Supervisors meeting the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:30 PM; The Planning Commission meeting the 3rd Tuesday of every month at 7:30 PM; and the Board of Supervisor Workshop Meetings the 3rd Thursday of every month at 11 AM. Mr. Jackson seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.
