Emergency Meeting Minutes

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, Adams County, met Thursday, March 25, 2020 at 4:35 PM, at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Road, Fairfield, PA 17320 to renew the declaration of disaster and discuss the impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Present: Chairman Walter Barlow, Vice-Chairman Robert Jackson, Supervisor Robert Keilholtz; Chief Sherri Hansen, and Secretary/Treasurer Wendy Peck.

Mr. Barlow called the meeting to order at 4:35 PM and stated that the purpose of meeting was to discuss the potential threat of the COVID-19 Pandemic disaster.

Mr. Barlow made a motion to adopt the new COVID-19 Pandemic disaster declaration with an expiration of midnight on April 7 allowing the Board to consider extending declaration at the April 7 Board of Supervisors meeting. Mr. Jackson seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion passed.

There was discussion about the Governor's recent closure of non-essential businesses, as well as compliance and enforcement of the order. Chief Hansen described how enforcement of non-compliant businesses was being handled.

Adjourn: At 4:45 PM Mr. Barlow moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Keilholtz seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion passed. The next regular Board of Supervisors meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020, at 7:30 PM at the Township Municipal Building.
