Regular Monthly Meeting June 7, 2011

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, Adams County, met Tuesday, *June 7*, 2011 at 7:30p.m.at the Liberty Township Municipal Building, 39 Topper Rd, Fairfield, for its regular monthly meeting.

<u>Supervisors' Remarks:</u> Mr. Foscato stated he authorized Ms. Frishkorn to move \$10,000.00 from the general fund to the capital reserve fund for this month and to move another \$10,000.00 in July.

New Business:

Act 176 Model Ordinance for Storm Water- Solicitor Davis recommends tabling the Ordinance until further notice. A motion to table until further notice by Mr. Bostek and seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.

Blue Ridge Summit Mylars- A motion to approve Blue Ridge Summit Mylars by Mr. Foscato and seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.

Deeds Mylars- A motion to approve Deeds Mylars by Mr. Jackson and seconded by Mr. Bostek and passed unanimously.

Non Sufficient Funds Fees- Mr. Jackson stated Mrs. Natalie Williams, Tax Collector is requesting permission to charge for return checks. A motion by Mr. Jackson to approve a \$15.00 fee for all returned checks was seconded by Mr. Bostek and passed unanimously.

Tax Duplicate Fees- Mr. Jackson stated Mrs. Natalie Williams, Tax Collector is requesting permission to charge for duplicate taxes. A motion to table duplicate tax fees for further investigation by Mr. Bostek was seconded by Mr. Jackson and passed unanimously.

Chief Harvey asked the Board for permission to request a traffic study of Route 16 from the county line to the state line to reduce the speed limit to 45 mph for the entire length. The Board will discus the matter further during a staff meeting.
